Background

The dietary questionnaire used by the ALSWH is known as the Dietary Questionnaire for Epidemiological Studies (DQES) Version 2 (see Appendix) and is the property of the Cancer Epidemiology Centre of The Cancer Council Victoria (CCV). The DQES was made available as part of a negotiated collaboration, with the following conditions as part of the Memorandum of understanding between the ALSWH and CCV.

1. The principle collaborators for the project are Penny Warner-Smith (ALSWH) and Alison Hodge (CCV) and are entitled to authorships on all publications arising from the measurement of food and nutrient intakes using the DQES in accordance with the ALSWH Publication Guidelines.
2. All publications arising from the measurement of food and nutrient intakes using the DQES will include the acknowledgement:
