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Notes

During 2007 and 2008, 10638 surveys were returned from members of the ALSWH cohort born between 1946 and 1951 and 10464 are summarised here. Of the 10638 surveys 174 were not able to be classified with respect to area of residence in Survey 5.

Data for the whole sample are presented in the "Weighted Total" column and split by area of residence in the other 4 columns: "Capital City/Other Metropolitan"; "Large Rural"; "Small Rural"; and "Other Rural/Remote". The "Weighted Total" column is weighted according to the area classification to account for deliberate over-sampling of women from rural and remote areas.

This work provides a summary of the responses to the questionnaire as well as variables derived from these responses. For information on the derived variables refer to the Data Dictionary and Data Dictionary Supplement found on the ALSWH website (<http://www.alwsh.org.au/>).
